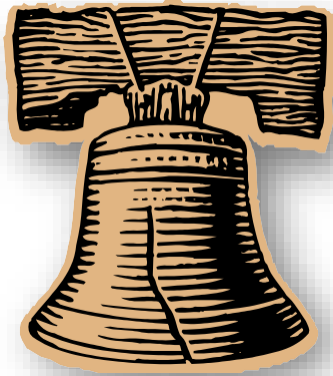

**E4 Dennis Harris
U.S. Army
Vietnam Veteran**

Dennis Harris was drafted into the US Army in July 1965. He completed Basic Training at Fort Dix and Advanced Infantry Training at Fort Benning. He was in Vietnam from 1966-1967. Dennis served as Radio Telephone Operator (RTO) to the Executive Officer of Charlie Company, 2nd Battalion, 7th Infantry Regiment of the famous 1st Cavalry Division (Airmobile), deployed to Vietnam to revolutionize warfare through helicopter-based troop transport, firepower, and rapid battlefield mobility. Dennis was a crucial soldier responsible for maintaining communication between units using radio and related equipment. With other Veterans he returned to Vietnam in May 1994. You will want to hear the rest of his story. Thank you, Dennis, for your honorable service to our country.
